Chapitre AOC Rully 1^{er} cru White

Parcel: Chapitre. It is the name of the Climat and its area. Adjacent to the houses of the village, it belonged to the famous chapter of monks of the Cathedral of Chalon (constructed on an ancient temple of Saint-Etienne in the 5th century, today dedicated to Saint Vincent, the patron saint of winemakers). In 816 the episcopal council of Aix-la-Chapelle had ordered the addition of a Canonical College under monastic orders, to be attached to the cathedral. This College was called "Le Chapitre". In winegrowing regions the monks also wanted to cultivate vines, and took care that they were well tended

Geographical situation: In the centre of the appellation, facing east. This walled parcel, at the bottom of a slope, is sunny and early ripening

Grape Variety: Chardonnay

Vineyard: Planted in 2000, surface 0.5226 acres

Soil and subsoil: Clay

Vinification: Handpicked, directly pressed without crushing. Static settling for 48 h before being put into barrels for alcoholic fermentation (20 % new barrels exclusively from the Tonnellerie Chassin)

Ageing: 12 months in barrel, then 6 months in stainless steel vats. Bottled according to the lunar calendar

Character: This parcel always gives rich wines full of tension and minerality, characterised by opulence and finesse

Serving Temperature: 12°
