

# DOMAINE DUREUIL-JANTHIAL



## Grésigny Vieilles Vignes AOC Rully 1<sup>er</sup> cru White

**Parcel:** Grésigny. It is the name of the Climat and its area. Well situated on the slopes of Mount Palais, with stony soils. The first mention of Grésigny appeared in the manuscripts of Saint-Marcel de Chalon, in 838: "In fine Ruliacense, in villa Gricunaco" (in the district of Rully, in the estate of Grésigny). There therefore existed a Gallo-roman villa here, the property of a certain Gracinius, a Roman citizen or a Gaul having taken Roman citizenship

**Geographical situation:** At Rully, in the south of the appellation, facing east

**Grape Variety:** Chardonnay

**Vineyard:** Planted in 1945, surface 0.1729 acres

**Soil and subsoil:** Limestone clay

**Vinification:** Handpicked, directly pressed without crushing. Static settling for 48 h before being put into barrels for alcoholic fermentation (20 % new barrels exclusively from the Tonnellerie Chassin)

**Ageing:** 12 months in barrel, then 6 months in stainless steel vats. Bottled according to the lunar calendar

**Character:** This parcel always gives opulent wines full of tension and minerality

**Serving Temperature:** 12°

**Format:** 75 cl
