## Le Meix Cadot Vieilles Vignes AOC Rully 1<sup>er</sup> cru White

Parcel: Le Meix Cadot. This Climat englobes several parcels: Le Meix Cadot, La Chaume and La Bergerie. Situated between two parcels known as En Guesnes, this Climat is a reminder of the existence of an ancient farm and its proprietor. For in Burgundy a Meix refers to a farm and the name that follows is that of its owner. (Cadot is a very common name in the Saône-et-Loire)

Geographical situation: Centre of the appellation, facing east

Grape Variety: Chardonnay

**Vineyard:** Planted in the twenties by my great grandfather Pierre Janthial, for a surface of 1.0900 acres

Soil and subsoil: Limestone clay

**Vinification:** Handpicked, directly pressed without crushing. Static settling for 48 h before being put into barrels for alcoholic fermentation (20 % new barrels exclusively from the Tonnellerie Chassin)

**Ageing:** 12 months in barrel, then 6 months in stainless steel vats. Bottled according to the lunar calendar

Character: This parcel always gives opulent wines full of tension and minerality

Serving Temperature: 12°
